

# PARIS - MARSEILLES - NICE - TOULOUSE - LYON - PARIS

## THURSDAY September 7th PARIS:

Arrive at your Parisian hotel for two nights. Welcome drinks with your SportsLink Travel Tour Manager tonight.

## FRIDAY September 8th PARIS:

Free day to acclimatise and explore magnificent Paris, the 'City of Light'. Late afternoon, meet your Tour Manager and transfer by Metro to the RWC2023 OPENING CEREMONY and NEW ZEALAND vs FRANCE at St Denis.

## SATURDAY September 9th PARIS:

Half day Paris city touring including such iconic Parisian sights as Notre Dame, Sacre Coeur, Montmartre, the Seine River and included Eiffel Tower entry. Early evening Metro transfer to AUSTRALIA vs EUROPE 1.

## SUNDAY September 10th MARSEILLE:

Early check out from hotel and coach transfer to your rapid TGV service to Marseille. Transfer to your hotel and then onto the Stade Velodrome for SOUTH AFRICA vs SCOTLAND.

## MONDAY September 11th MARSEILLES:

Free day to embrace vibrant Marseilles, France's oldest city and gateway to the Mediterranean.

## TUESDAY September 12th NICE:

This morning we travel from Marseilles to Cannes on the French Riviera, a resort town famed for its international film festival. Its Boulevard de la Croisette, curving along the coast, is lined with sandy beaches, upmarket boutiques and palatial hotels. Later today we journey on to Nice and our central city hotel, just a short walk from the famed Promenade des Anglais.

## WEDNESDAY September 13th NICE:

After a leisurely breakfast, we embark on our excursion into the principality of Monaco, where we will view the famous Casino de Monte-Carlo and the Prince's Palace. This afternoon we travel to Menton and visit the burial site of William Webb Ellis, before returning to Nice, with a stop at the internationally acclaimed Fragonard Parfumerie en route.

## THURSDAY September 14th TOULOUSE:

Bid adieu to Nice as we head west to rugby-mad Toulouse via the neoclassical city of Montpellier.

## FRIDAY September 15th TOULOUSE:

Day at leisure in La Ville Rose ('The Pink City') so named due to the terra-cotta bricks used in so many of the buildings here. Tonight we gather and transfer to the NEW ZEALAND vs AFRICA 1 at Stade Toulousain



### SATURDAY September 16th LYON:

We travel today to Lyon, the gastronomical capital of France - and that's saying something! A city best explored on foot or by bike, gateway to the Rhone Valley and home to numerous fascinating museums and galleries.

### SUNDAY September 17th LYON:

Free morning and then coach to nearby St Etienne for the final match of this tour, AUSTRALIA vs FIJI.

### MONDAY September 18th PARIS:

Check out of the hotel and drive through to Paris for the final two nights of the tour.

### TUESDAY September 19th PARIS:

Today is yours to tick all those boxes in Paris that you've yet to tick - maybe a trip out to Versailles, or a skip across town to visit Jim Morrison's grave, perhaps a visit to The Louvre to see The Mona Lisa.
